No One Left Unhelped Inc. Volunteer Report 2019

No One Left Unhelped Inc. (NOLU) is a 501c3 organization located in the Sandtown/Winchester Community of Baltimore City. The vision is to provide overall community support, strategies for improvement of family units, and awareness of low-income families impacted by violence. The mission is to combine community beautification, support in healing, and anti-violence tactics to reduce pollution and break the cycle of violence in our community.

The organization was founded in 2016 by a group of family survivors of gun violence. Concerned about the well-being of children impacted by violence, they decided to establish a therapeutic group to safeguard the children, provide treatment and allow children age 5-18 years old to partner with children around the world on Global Service Days, and to take on new roles being a part of meaningful change in the community where they live.

According to the data below, in the year of 2019, NOLU engaged 1,084 volunteers, donating over 5,342 in-kind hours; and providing direct services to 5,218 children in order to help change the cycle of violence in Baltimore City:

Youth Interns Efforts

30 Youth Interns

- 5 hours a week cleaning and greening x 40 weeks
 - 6,000 intern and service learning hours earned by youth age 10-23

Block Clean Ups

- 108 block clean ups
- 327 toal volunteers
 - 76 volunteers worked 85-100 hours over multiple events
 - 51 volunteers worked 8-10 hours for 1 to 2 events
 - 200 volunteers worked 4 hours for one event

Peace Marches & Community Givebacks

- Founder's Effort
 - Lisa Molock volunteered 50 hours a week for 52 weeks = 2600 in-kind hours, not to include administrative duties and Peace Marches
- Community Givebacks
 - 28 volunteers worked 12 events for 6 hours each for 432 in-kind hours
 - 119 volunteers worked 1 event for 6 hours donating 714 in-kind hours
- Peace Marches
 - 399 volunteers participated in several peace marches averaging 4 hours for a total of 1596 volunteer in-kind hours

Because of these efforts, NOLU has impacted the lives of approximately 4,000 residents, as well as raised \$13,000 in a fundraiser to make a deposit on a 15-passenger-van. This enabled the organization to provide door to door service for volunteers during community cleanup projects.
